

**ORDINANCE NO. 1083****AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL FOR  
THE BOROUGH OF MOUNT UNION  
ESTABLISHING CERTAIN PARKING REGULATIONS  
AND A THREE-WAY STOP INTERSECTION AT  
EAST MARKET STREET AND SOUTH SHAVER STREET**

**NOW THEEFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Borough Council of the Borough Of Mount Union, Huntingdon County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Borough Code, as amended, as follows:

**Section 1.**

From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, parking shall be prohibited on the south side of East Market Street within a distance of forty feet (40') on each side of the intersection of East Market Street with South Shaver Street.

**Section 2.**

From and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the following intersections of East Market Street with South Shaver Street shall be designated as "STOP" intersections:

- A. East Market Street with South Shaver Street – eastbound lane of traffic (Three Way);
- B. South Shaver Street with East Market Street – northbound lane of traffic (Three Way); and
- C. South Shaver Street with East Market Street – southbound lane of traffic (Three Way).

**Section 3.**

The appropriate Borough officials are hereby authorized to cause to be erected and to be maintained by the Borough, the necessary and appropriate official "STOP" signs and curb markings, as required by Section 1 and Section 2 above; at the following specific designated corners of said intersection:

- A. Southwest corner of East Market Street with South Shaver Street for the eastbound lane of traffic;
- B. Southeast corner of South Shaver Street with East Market Street for the northbound lane of traffic; and
- C. Northwest corner of South Shaver Street with East Market Street for the southbound lane of traffic.

**Section 4.**

All other parking spaces and "No Parking" areas currently in existence will remain as enacted and without any change.

**Section 5.**

All other stop signs, curb markings, and travel directions, including one-way street sections, currently in existence will remain as enacted without any change.

**Section 6.**

Any violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine as is set forth in the Motor Vehicle Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

**Section 7.**

All provisions of previous ordinances of the Borough of Mount Union or parts thereof, which are contrary to or inconsistent with this Ordinance, are expressly repealed.

**Section 8.**

In all other respects, the ordinances of the Borough of Mount Union shall remain as previously enacted and ordained.

**Section 9.**

If any section, paragraph, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 10.**

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment as provided by law.


