INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

This Agreement by and among the County of Bedford, the County of Fulton and the County of Huntingdon, dated the 30th day of April, 2019 is set forth as follows:

1. The parties hereto are parties to an Agreement known as the South Central Solid Waste Agency Agreement.

2. The parties to the Agreement are responsible to develop and implement a Solid Waste Management Plan and practice.

3. The parties are seeking to hire an Engineer/Consultant to assist in developing a Solid Waste Management Plan for the three (3) counties to operate and manage collectively.

4. The parties have awarded an Engineer/Consultant contract to Barton & Loguidice, D. P. C., of Liverpool, New York.

5. The parties to this Agreement acknowledge that the County of Huntingdon will pay the upfront fees and expenses of the Consultant. The South Central Solid Waste Agency joint account will reimburse the County of Huntingdon their up-front cost. Any grant monies received for the purposes of the plan development will reimburse the South Central Solid Waste Agency joint account upon receipt. Each county is responsible for their share of the in-kind match and any other associated costs with developing and adopting the plan.

WHEREFORE, the parties hereto hereby enter into this Agreement intending to be legally bound hereby.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act, Act of July 28, 1988, P.L. 528, No. 101 (Act 101) gave the County primary responsibility for planning for municipal waste management within its boundaries and for securing sufficient disposal capacity for all municipal waste generated within its boundaries; and

WHEREAS, Section 303(d) of Act 101 authorizes counties to enter into an agreement with another person, including a municipal authority, pursuant to which that person undertakes to fulfill some or all of the County's responsibilities under Act 101 for municipal waste planning and implementation of the approved County Plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the request of the Department of Environmental Protection, Bedford County Planning Department with the SWAC has prepared the Bedford, Fulton, and Huntingdon County Joint Municipal Waste Plan Update of 2021 (the 2021 Plan); and

WHEREAS, the Bedford County Board of Commissioners believes that the 2021 Plan is appropriate and necessary to protect the health and welfare of the residents of the County; and




